87. QUOTATION QUESTION. Which of the Ten Commandments prohibits the worshiping of idols?

Exodus 20:4 You shall not make for yourself an image ...

199. QUOTATION QUESTION. What great statement did Peter make about Jesus?

Matthew 16:16 ...You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God.

233. QUOTATION QUESTION. What did Peter say to the lame man at the temple gate?

Acts 3:6 ...Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk.

326. QUOTATION QUESTION. According to Luke's Gospel, why did Jesus come to earth?

Luke 19:10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.

355. QUOTATION QUESTION. What did Jesus tell Nicodemus was necessary for a person to see the kingdom of God?

John 3:3 ...Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again.

365. QUOTATION QUESTION. From Romans chapter one, quote the verse which tells us the power of the gospel.

Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes...

366. QUOTATION QUESTION. Quote the verse of Ephesians chapter two which tells us how we are saved.

Ephesians 2:8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God

John 15:13 Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends.

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

499. **QUOTATION QUESTION. Quote the verse which** declares only Jesus can give us salvation.

Acts 4:12 Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.

502. **QUOTATION QUESTION. What prophecy did Jesus** make to Nicodemus concerning His atoning death?

John 3:14,15 Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes may have eternal life in him.

505. **QUOTATION QUESTION. Quote the verse of Matthew's** Gospel which tells of Jesus' supernatural birth.

Matthew 1:23 The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him "Immanuel" (which means "God with us")

507. **QUOTATION QUESTION. What saying** of Jesus to Martha tells us that Jesus has power over death?

John 11:25 ...I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die...

517. **QUOTATION QUESTION. Quote the invitation** of Jesus contained in Revelation chapter three.

Revelation 3:20 Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me.

518. **QUOTATION QUESTION.** According to Romans chapter ten, what should we do to be saved?

Romans 10:9 If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

521. **QUOTATION QUESTION.** What definition of faith is found in Hebrews 11:1?

Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

532. **QUOTATION QUESTION.** Quote the Lord's Prayer.

Matthew 6:9-13 ...Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

533. **QUOTATION QUESTION.** From the first Psalm, quote the definition of the blessed man.

Psalms 1:1 Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers

534. **QUOTATION QUESTION.** Quote the verse in Psalms which tells us why believers do not need to fear death.

Psalms 23:4 Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

Romans 12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.

Philippians 4:6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.

Philippians 4:8 Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable— if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.

1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

545. **QUOTATION QUESTION.** What does an Old Testament proverb say about hiding our sins?

Proverbs 28:13 Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy.

547. **QUOTATION QUESTION.** What verse in Psalms gives us guidance about TV and computer programs, movies, and other media?

Psalms 101:3 I will not look with approval on anything that is vile. I hate what faithless people do; I will have no part in it.

552. **QUOTATION QUESTION.** As listed in Galatians, what is the fruit of the Spirit?

Galatians 5:22,23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

563. **QUOTATION QUESTION.** Quote the verse of Second Corinthians which tells us how to give.

2 Corinthians 9:7 Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

Pharaoh's baker and cupbearer [butler] *Genesis 40:5*

By showing Moses a piece of wood [tree] to throw into the water *Exodus 15:24,25*

165. **What happened to Daniel** when he continued to pray to God instead of to the king?

He was thrown into the lions' den. *Daniel 6:4-16*

174. **What two groups** of men worshiped the Christ child?

Shepherds and Magi [Wise Men] *Luke 2:8-14; Matthew 2:1,2*

362. **What did the prodigal son** say to his father when he came back home?

I have sinned against heaven [God] and you and am no longer worthy to be your son. *Luke 15:21*

395. **According to First John,** what are the three common temptations?

Lust of the flesh [cravings of sinful man]; lust of the eyes; and the pride of life [boasting about oneself] *1 John 2:16*

548. **What three supernatural** things happened on the Day of Pentecost?

A sound like the blowing of a violent [mighty rushing] wind was heard.
Divided tongues of fire appeared.
Disciples spoke in languages they had never learned. *Acts 2:2-4*
